On Friday, March 25, 2016, at approximately 2:10 p.m., 27-year old Robert Ellis, Jr. was standing with a group of men in front of a business located at 5507 South Vermont Avenue in Los Angeles, when an unknown individual approached the group on foot and opened fire in their direction. Mr. Ellis was fatally struck by the gunfire and collapsed, as the suspect fled on foot. Detectives are continuing to investigate this crime, but have not yet been able to identify the suspect. Detectives believe a reward may compel members of the public to provide information on the identity of the person responsible for this crime. The person or persons responsible for this crime represent an ongoing threat to the safety of the people of Los Angeles. Unless withdrawn or paid by City Council action, this offer of reward shall terminate on, and have no effect after, OCTOBER 16, 2016.

The provisions of payment and all other considerations shall be governed by Chapter 12 of Division 19 of the LAAC Code, as amended by Ordinance Nos. 158157 and 166666. El viernes 25 de marzo de 2016, aproximadamente a las 2:10 p.m., Robert Ellis, Jr. de 27 años de edad estaba parado con un grupo de hombres en frente de un negocio ubicado en 5507 South Vermont Avenue en Los Angeles, cuando un individuo desconocido se acercó al grupo a pie y abrió fuego en su dirección. El Sr. Ellis fue fatalmente impactado por el tiro y colapsó, mientras el sospechoso huyó a pie. Los detectives continúan investigando este crimen, pero aún no han sido capaces de identificar a los sospechosos. Los detectives creen que una recompensa puede obligar a los miembros del público a proporcionar información sobre la identidad de las personas responsables de este crimen. La persona o personas responsables de este delito representan una amenaza constante para la seguridad de los habitantes de Los Angeles.
