

## MOTION


I MOVE that the matter of the MOTION and JOINT CHIEF LEGISLATIVE ANALYST AND CITY ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER REPORT relative to amending the Bond Expenditure Agreement and related Bond Spending Plan between the Community Redevelopment Agency of Los Angeles, a Designated Local Authority (CRA/LA-DLA) and the City of Los Angeles (City), Item No. 33 on today's Continuation Council agenda (CF 14-1174) BE AMENDED to add the following recommendations:

- 1) DIRECT the City of Los Angeles Department of Transportation to establish a Memorandum of Understanding with the Los Angeles Unified School District that commits both entities to work together on a Strategic Plan to find multiple ways to fund the Safe Routes to Schools program and prioritizes those areas of our city that are of most urgent need.
- 2) ADD language to Section 4 of the Bond Expenditure Agreement to include the following provision under the City's Obligations as Section 4.8 to read as follows:



4.8 MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH LOS ANGELES UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT

The City shall enter into good faith negotiations with the Los Angeles Unified School District (LAUSD) on a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) to advance the design and implementation of measures to increase the safety of children and adults traveling to and from mutually designated high priority school sites. The MOU shall identify potential funding sources for these efforts including but not limited to future Safe Routes to Schools and other federal and state grant funds, application and leverage of CRA/LA excess bond funds, and MTA call for projects grants, as appropriate.
