MOTION

As the fourth busiest airport in the world, the Los Angeles World Airports (LAWA) serves tens of millions of passengers every year, offers hundreds of daily nonstop flights, processes billions of dollars of cargo tonnage annually, and is a major economic driver of the region by generating hundreds of thousands of jobs and billions of dollars in revenues.

In addition to managing its daily operations, LAWA is in the midst of a major terminal construction and renovation project, and a multi-billion dollar modernization program. It is an important time for the City Council to stay informed, particularly as LAWA continues to burgeon during these next several years.

As Section 242(b) of the Los Angeles City Charter states: The duty of the Council and its committees is to become fully informed of the business of the City so as to oversee all the functions of the City government, and to report to the Council any information or recommendations necessary to enable the Council to properly legislate.

It is also pertinent for certain updates to be shared and directly presented by the lead executive of LAWA.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the City Council request the Chief Executive Officer of Los Angeles World Airports to provide quarterly reports to the Trade, Travel, and Tourism Committee on the status of department activities, which may include but not be limited to: operations, finances, capital improvement projects, public safety and security, planning, technology, and marketing/promotions.
