An ordinance repealing City ordinance numbers 76,896, 77,302, 78,193, 87,022, 93,631, 107,271, 108,896, 110,625, 125,282, 132,411 and 140,292 to reinstate certain streets for public use.

DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

- Sec. 5. Ordinance No. 93,631, adopted August 4, 1948, is hereby repealed.
- Sec. 6. Ordinance No. 107,271, adopted March 29, 1956, is hereby repealed.
- Sec. 7. Ordinance No. 108,896, adopted January 31, 1957, is hereby repealed.
- Sec. 8. Ordinance No. 110,625, adopted December 10, 1957, is hereby repealed.
- Sec. 9. Ordinance No. 125,282, adopted August 6, 1963, is hereby repealed.
- Sec. 10. Ordinance No. 132,411, adopted May 12, 1966, is hereby repealed.

The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and have it published in accordance with Council policy, either in a daily newspaper circulated in the City of Los Angeles or by posting for ten days in three public places in the City of Los Angeles: one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall; one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall East; and one copy on the bulletin board located at the Temple Street entrance to the Los Angeles County Hall of Records.


