Comments for Public Posting: “During the COVID-19 pandemic, the homeless services system has worked hard to temporarily house thousands of our most vulnerable neighbors experiencing homelessness. We now must provide them pathways to permanent housing to ensure that they do not end up back on the streets. By cutting the Rehousing funding in the CAO's report from \$97M to \$30M, we would leave over 2,000 of our temporarily housed neighbors without a permanent solution. We need the City Council to amend Item 23 and approve \$97M to permanently house 3,000 of our most vulnerable neighbors, as outlined in the CAO's original report
