**\$50,000 REWARD NOTICE**  
The City of Los Angeles offers a reward payable at the discretion of the City Council to one or more persons in the sum or sums up to an aggregate maximum total sum of \$50,000 for information leading to the identification and apprehension of the person or persons responsible for the SHOOTING DEATH OF MICHAEL KELLY, in the City of Los Angeles. On February 15, 2020, Michael Kelly was walking with his friend near Van Nuys Boulevard and Glendale Boulevard, in Pacoima when they were confronted by two unknown individuals in a dark colored sedan. One of the suspects asked Mr. Kelly if he "smoked" to which Mr. Kelly said no. One of the suspects then pulled out a handgun and shot at Mr. Kelly and his friend, striking Mr. Kelly in the side, fatally wounding him before fleeing the scene. Detectives continue to investigate this crime but have been unable to identify the suspects. The detectives believe a reward may compel members of the public to provide information on the person or persons responsible for this crime. The person or persons responsible for this crime represent an ongoing threat to the safety of the people of Los Angeles; therefore, it is appropriate for the City of Los Angeles to offer a reward for information leading to the identification, apprehension and conviction of the person or persons responsible for this crime. Unless withdrawn or paid by City Council action, this offer of reward shall remain on, and have no effect after FEBRUARY 20, 2021. The provisions of payment and all other considerations shall be governed by Chapter 12 of Division 19 of the LAAAC Code, as amended by Ordinance Nos. 168157 and 169666. This offer shall be given upon the condition that all claimants provide continued cooperation within the criminal justice system relative to this case and is not available to public officers or employees of the City, their families, persons in law enforcement, or persons whose misconduct prompted this reward.
