HOMELESSNESS AND POVERTY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to an in-depth analysis of the health services delivery system, and the City's Health Commission hearings focused on people experiencing homelessness.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (O'Farrell - Martinez - Cedillo - Rodriguez et al.):

- 1. DIRECT the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA) and the City Administrative Officer (CAO), with the assistance of the Los Angeles Housing and Community Investment Department (HCIDLA), and all relevant City departments, to review the delivery of health, mental health, and social services by the County of Los Angeles, to the over 41,000 unsheltered residents within the city limits, including the coordination of those services between the County, Los Angeles Homelessness Service Authority (LAHSA) and non-governmental partners, and report to Council with recommendations as outlined in the body of Motion (O'Farrell Martinez Cedillo Rodriguez et al.), attached to the Council file.
- REQUEST the Los Angeles City Health Commission, with the assistance of the CLA, CAO and City Clerk, to hold hearings focused on people experiencing homelessness and the delivery of health, mental health and social services by the County of Los Angeles, LAHSA and other non-governmental partners.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: Neither the CAO nor the CLA has competed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

At its regular meeting held on October 8, 2020, the Homelessness and Poverty Committee considered Motion (O'Farrell - Martinez - Cedillo - Rodriguez et al.) relative to an in-depth analysis of the health services delivery system, and the City's Health Commission hearings focused on people experiencing homelessness.
