## MOTION

The City-owned Old Junipero Serra Library, located at 4255 South Olive Street, was retrofitted in 2000, and is currently used by some of the City's non-profit partners to provide vital services for residents. Two non-profits, the Coalition for Responsible Community Development, which provides a number of youth development and workforce development services, and the Coalition for Humane Immigrant Rights, which provides immigrants and new Americans with assistance are currently in need of space, and the Old Junipero Serra Library would be a good location for both.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Department of General Services, with the assistance of the City Attorney's Office and City Administrative Officer, BE DIRECTED to negotiate a non-profit lease and/or license agreement with the Coalition for Responsible Community Development (CRCD) and Coalition for Humane Immigrant Rights (CHIRLA), for a term of 25 years, for space in the Old Junipero Serra Library, located at 4255 South Olive Street.
