#### Dear Honorable Members:

Transmitted herewith for City Council consideration is the reappropriation of funds for FY 2016 Program to Prepare Communities for Complex Coordinated Terrorist Attacks (CCTA) Grant from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS) Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). The CCTA projects outlined in this report were approved previously and this request is to continue to fund these projects through the end of the grant performance period.

On June 8, 2018, the City Council accepted the FY 2016 CCTA grant in the amount of \$1,223,225 with a grant performance period from September 1, 2017 to August 31, 2020 (Council File No. 18-0151).

## Los Angeles Fire Department

The Mayor's Office is requesting a total of \$50,000 to be reappropriated to the Los Angeles Fire Department (LAFD) for approved CCTA projects for the Fiscal Year 2019-20. The LAFD will provide Subject Matter Expert (SME) support on grant objectives and planning material development on an overtime basis.

### Los Angeles Police Department

The Mayor's Office is requesting a total of \$12,426.88 to be reappropriated to the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) for approved CCTA projects for the Fiscal Year 2019-20. LAPD. With these funds, the LAPD will provide SME support on grant objectives and exercise planning and implementation on an overtime basis.





Authority is being requested to transfer and create new appropriations, as noted above. *Mayor's Office* 

The federal grant guidelines allow up to 5% of the CCTA grant for salary and fringe benefit costs for grant and financial management staff. As the administrator and fiscal agent of the CCTA grant, the Mayor's Office funds grant and financial management staff with the allowable 5% of management and administration (M&A) funds. These costs were approved previously and the request is to continue to fund M&A until the grant deadline. The total amount being reappropriated for M&A is \$17,563.78.

Authority is being requested to transfer and create new appropriations, as noted above.

- 5. **Authorize** the Mayor, or his designee, to prepare Controller instructions for any technical accounting adjustments, subject to approval of the City Administrative Officer, and, authorize the Controller to implement the instructions.
