Honorable Members:

On December 2, 2019, this Office transmitted a draft ordinance adding Chapter 186 to the Los Angeles Administrative Code. The draft ordinance would establish a Youth Sports Partnership Fund for the receipt, retention, and disbursement of funds the City anticipates receiving pursuant to the Host City Contract for the 2028 Olympic and Paralympic Games. The funds will be used to support the development of youth sports.

This Office has prepared and now transmits for your consideration the enclosed revised draft ordinance, approved as to form and legality. This revised draft ordinance makes limited technical corrections to ensure consistent reference to the Youth Sport Partnership, the Youth Sport Partnership Fund, and the Los Angeles Organizing Committee of the Olympic and Paralympic Games 2028, respectively, in related documents.

In all other respects, the language of the draft ordinance remains unchanged and replaces the version of the draft ordinance submitted on December 2, 2019.
