



RECOMMENDATION

That the Council, subject to the approval of the Mayor, authorize the Chief of Police, or designee, to execute the Sixth Amendment to Contract No. C-124017 between the City of Los Angeles and ASSI Security, Inc. for security management system services, subject to the review and approval by the City Attorney as to form. The Sixth Amendment will extend the term of the contract an additional two years from June 5, 2020 through June 4, 2022.

SUMMARY

The Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) requests authority to execute the Sixth Amendment to Contract No. C-124017 between the City of Los Angeles and ASSI Security, Inc. for security management services. The Sixth Amendment will extend the term of the contract an additional two years from June 5, 2020 through June 4, 2022. The LAPD states that due to the recent pandemic, extending the term of the contract will allow LAPD sufficient time to conduct the Request for Proposals (RFP) process for security management services, which includes repair services, new components/equipment, and upgrades for the LAPD's security systems.

The original agreement was from June 5, 2014 through June 4, 2017 with the option to extend for two additional years in one-year increments. Subsequent to the original agreement, the contract was amended five times as follows: the First Amendment replaced Appendix C (Master Price List). The Second Amendment provided the first one-year extension of the original agreement term from June 5, 2017 through June 4, 2018. The Third Amendment provided the second one-year extension of the original agreement term from June 5, 2018 through June 4, 2019, and updated the City's Standard Provisions for City Contracts (Rev. 10/17) [v.2]. The Fourth Amendment provided a one-year extension of the original agreement term from June 5, 2019 through June 4, 2020 (Council File 14-0649), and updated the City's Standard Provisions for City Contracts (Rev. 10/17) [v.3]. The Fifth Amendment increased the maximum compensation limit to \$3,000,000 (Council File 14-0649). The proposed Sixth Amendment will extend the term of the contract for an additional two years from June 5, 2020 through June 4, 2022.

This Office finds that the proposed Amendment qualifies for exemption from the contractual services policy in the Mayor's Fiscal Year 2020-21 Cost Containment Measures memo dated June 24, 2020, as the services provided through this Amendment are essential to public health and safety. ASSI Security will maintain repair services, add new components/equipment, and provide upgrades for the LAPD's security systems to ensure the safety of officers, civilian staff, arrestees, and inmates at LAPD facilities. Discontinued use of these services may result in security breaches that could compromise personal safety and property.

In accordance with the Los Angeles Administrative Code Section 10.5(b)(2), Council approval of the proposed Amendment is required because the cumulative term of the contract exceeds three years. To the best of our knowledge, the Contractor has complied with all standard provisions for City contracts.

FISCAL IMPACT STATEMENT

Approval of the recommendation in this report will have no additional impact to the General Fund. Funding for this contract has already been provided in the Police Department's FY 2020-21 Contractual Services Account.

FINANCIAL POLICIES STATEMENT

The recommendation in this report complies with the City's Financial Policies in that contract expenditures will be limited to the use of approved budgeted funds.

The Contractor was selected through a Request for Proposals. The First through Fifth Amendments made a technical change to the price list of the Original Agreement, extended the term of the agreement an additional three years ending on June 4, 2020, and increased the total compensation to \$3,000,000.

**SIXTH AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT NUMBER C-124017
BETWEEN THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES
AND
ASSI SECURITY, INC., FOR SECURITY MANAGEMENT SYSTEM**

This **SIXTH AMENDMENT** ("Sixth Amendment") to Los Angeles City Contract No. C-124017 ("Original Agreement") is made and entered into by and between the City of Los Angeles, a municipal corporation, (hereinafter referred to as "City"), acting by and through the Los Angeles Police Department, (hereinafter referred to as "LAPD" or "Department"), and ASSI Security, Inc., a California corporation, (hereinafter referred to as "Contractor").

RECITALS

WHEREAS, on June 5, 2014, the LAPD and Contractor entered into an Agreement to design, upgrade, supply, and install Security Management Systems ("SMS" or "System"), for Department facilities; and

WHEREAS, Section 10 of the Original Agreement, provides for Amendments to the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the First Amendment to the Original Agreement made a technical change to Appendix C, Master Price List, of the Original Agreement without changing the scope of work or the total compensation allocated under the Original Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Second Amendment to the Original Agreement exercised the first Option to extend the term of the Original Agreement for one year, beginning June 5, 2017 through June 4, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Third Amendment to the Original Agreement exercised the second Option to extend the term of the Original Agreement for one year, beginning June 5, 2018 through June 4, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Fourth Amendment extended the term of the Original Agreement for an additional one-year period, beginning June 5, 2019 through June 4, 2020 ("Option Term") and incorporated the Standard Provisions for City Contracts (rev. 10/17) [v3] regarding Attachment 1 of the Third Amendment; and;

WHEREAS, the Fifth Amendment increased the current contract limit from \$1,000,000 to \$3,000,000 to allow for projects to be completed and paid for; and

WHEREAS, the Contractor is willing to perform the work under the terms and conditions of the Original Agreement; and

WHEREAS, this Sixth Amendment is necessary and proper to extend the term of the agreement for an additional two-year period.

NOW THEREFORE, the City and the Contractor agree that the Original Agreement, as previously amended, be further amended as follows:

1. Extension of the Term of the Original Agreement. City and Contractor hereby agree that the term of the Original Agreement as set forth in Section 2.0 of the Original Agreement entitled "Term of the Agreement" is hereby extended for an additional two-year period, beginning June 5, 2020 through June 4, 2022, unless terminated as provided in Section 9.0 of the Original Agreement.
2. Ratification – Due to the need for the Contractor's services to be provided, should the Contractor provide services prior to the execution of this Sixth Amendment, to the extent that such services are satisfactorily performed, those services are hereby ratified.
3. In the event of an inconsistency between any of the provisions of this Sixth Amendment to Contract No. C-124017, or all prior or current attachments, the inconsistency shall be resolved by giving previous attachments and/or amendments precedence in the following order:
 - 1) Sixth Amendment to Contract No. C-124017,
 - 2) Fifth Amendment to Contract No. C-124017,
 - 3) Fourth Amendment to Contract No. C-124017,
 - 4) Third Amendment to Contract No. C-124017,
 - 5) Second Amendment to Contract No. C-124017,
 - 6) First Amendment to Contract No. C-124017,
 - 7) LAPD Contract No. C-124017, and
 - 8) Standard Provisions for City Contracts (Rev. 10/17) [v.3].

Except as amended by the First through Sixth Amendments, all other terms and conditions of the Original Agreement shall remain in full force and effect. The Original Agreement is hereby incorporated by reference, in its entirety, into this Sixth Amendment.

This Agreement may be executed in one or more counterparts, and by the parties in separate counterparts, each of which when executed shall be deemed to be an original but all of which taken together shall constitute one and the same agreement. The parties further agree that facsimile signatures or signatures scanned into .pdf (or signatures in another electronic format designated by City) and sent by e-mail shall be deemed original signatures. This Sixth Amendment includes three (3) pages.


