\$50,000 REWARD

NOTICE

The City of Los Angeles offers a reward payable at the discretion of the City Council to one or more persons in the sum or sums up to an aggregate maximum total sum of \$50,000 for information leading to the identification and apprehension of the "TEARDROP RAPIST", in the City of Los Angeles. Since 1999, a sexual predator dubbed the "Teardrop Rapist" has preyed on teenage girls and young women between the ages of 14-27 throughout the City of Los Angeles. The suspect has been described as a male Latino, approximately 5'5" to 5'9", slight to medium build, brown hair and eyes, with one or two teardrop tattoos under his right or left eye which he may have attempted to remove. To date, over 20 sexual assaults have taken place during the early morning hours that have been linked, either through DNA evidence, or modus operandi to this sexual predator suspect. Los Angeles Police Department detectives have conducted an exhaustive investigation and have been unable to identify the suspect, and believe that no new information will develop without community assistance. The person or persons responsible for this crime represent an ongoing threat to the safety of the people of Los Angeles. Unless withdrawn or paid by City Council action, this offer of reward shall terminate on, and have no effect after, MAY 9, 2020.

The provisions of payment and all other considerations shall be governed by Chapter 12 of Division 19 of the LAAC Code, as amended by Ordinance Nos. 158152 and 166666. This offer shall be given upon the condition that all claimants provide continued cooperation within the criminal justice system relative to this case and is not available to public officers or employees of the City, their families, persons in law enforcement or persons whose misconduct prompted this reward. Desde 1989, un depredador sexual apodado como el "Volador de la Lágrima" ha atacado a niñas adolescentes y mujeres jóvenes entre las edades de 14 a 27 en toda la Ciudad de Los Angeles. El sospechoso ha sido descrito como un hombre Latino, de

aproximadamente 5'5" a 5'9", de estructura delgada a media, cabello y ojos café, con uno o dos tatuajes en

forma de lagrima bajo el ojo derecho o izquierdo que pudo haber tratado de

eliminar, hasta la fecha, más de 20 agresiones sexuales han tenido lugar durante las

horas de la madrugada que ha sido vinculado, ya sea a través de las pruebas de ADN o el modus operandi de

este sospechoso depredador sexual. Los detectives del Departamento de Policía de Los Angeles han llevado a cabo una investigación exhaustiva y no han podido

identificar al sospechoso, y creen que no se desarrollará información nueva sin la ayuda de la comunidad.

La persona o personas responsables de este delito representan una amenaza constante para la seguridad de los habitantes de Los Angeles. A menos que se retire o se pague la acción por medio del Consejo de la Ciudad, esta oferta de

recompensa terminará, y no tendrá ningún efecto posterior al 9 DE MAYO 2020.
