The suspect has been described as a male Latino, approximately 5'5 to 5'9", slight to medium build, brown hair and eyes, with one or two teardrop tattoos under his right or left eye which he may have attempted to remove. To date, over 20 sexual assaults have taken place during the early morning hours that have been linked, either through DNA evidence, or modus operandi to this sexual predator suspect. Los Angeles Police Department detectives have conducted an exhaustive investigation and have been unable to identify the suspect, and believe that no new information will develop without community assistance. The person or persons responsible for this crime represent an ongoing threat to the safety of the people of Los Angeles. Unless withdrawn or paid by City Council action, this offer of reward shall terminate on, and have no effect after, MARCH 14, 2020.

The provisions of payment and all other considerations shall be governed by Chapter 12 of Division 19 of the LAAC Code, as amended by Ordinance Nos. 158157 and 166866.
