

MOTION

I MOVE that the Council Action of September 11, 2019 relative to the San Pedro Little Italy Project (CF 19-1043), BE AMENDED to direct / authorize the Bureau of Engineering to prepare, process and execute the necessary document(s) with, and/or payment(s) to Gensler, a City consultant, to move forward on the next phases of more detailed analysis and design work for this Project, utilizing the Pipeline Franchise Revenue portion of the Council District 15 Real Property Trust Fund already set aside in the original Council Action, and subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form, if needed.

I FURTHER MOVE that \$500,000 in the Pipeline Franchise Revenue portion of the Council District 15 Real Property Trust Fund No. 697 be transferred / appropriated to the Account in the Engineering Special Services Fund No. 682-50 entitled: "San Pedro Little Italy Plaza," for planning and design services to be provided by Gensler for the San Pedro Little Italy Project located at a City owned plaza next to the San Pedro Municipal Building in Council District 15.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Bureau of Engineering be directed / authorized to prepare and execute the necessary document(s) with, and/or payment(s) to Gensler, or any other agency or organization, as appropriate, in the above amount, for the above purpose, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form, if needed.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Council FIND that the services to be performed by Gensler are for the performance of professional, scientific, expert, technical, or other special services of a temporary and occasional character for which competitive bidding is not practicable or advantageous and that the work can be performed more economically or feasibly by independent contractors than by City employees.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Bureau of Engineering be authorized to make any corrections, clarifications or revisions to the above fund transfer instructions, including any new instructions, in order to effectuate the intent of this Motion, and including any corrections and changes to fund or account numbers; said corrections / clarifications / changes may be made orally, electronically or by any other means.
