Comments for Public Posting: Dear City Officials, I hope adding City Council approval to the process of exempting street segments from tour bus traffic will not make the process too difficult. All streets that are substandard, have weight limits, and sit in very high fire hazard zones should be exempted for obvious safety reasons. Hollywoodland has all three of these conditions and in addition uniquely sits as a bottleneck into Griffith Park, 80 % surrounded by dry brush with extremely limited egress and ingress.
