





I THEREFORE MOVE that the City Council provide an offer of reward for information leading to the identification, apprehension and conviction of the person(s) responsible for the murder of Desiree Haro and in support thereof make the following findings pursuant to Division 19, Chapter 12, Article 1 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code:

- 1. That the death of Desiree Haro was caused by the irresponsible use of a weapon.
