
MOTION

On December 3, 2019, the City Council approved an airspace vacation request by the Los Angeles County Museum of Art (LACMA) for the airspace over a portion of Wilshire Boulevard (C.F. 17-0545). The vacation is needed to allow LACMA to construct its new museum building, which will span over Wilshire Boulevard.

However, before a final Resolution to Vacate is recorded, LACMA is required to make specific site improvements and meet other conditions as required by the City Council's December 3, 2019 action. In order to allow LACMA to proceed with construction, while it meets these vacation conditions, LACMA is seeking the issuance of a revocable permit to occupy the airspace above Wilshire Boulevard between Spaulding Avenue and Stanley Avenue.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Bureau of Engineering be authorized to issue a revocable permit to the Los Angeles County Museum of Art, subject to satisfaction of the conditions for issuing such permit, to allow for the construction of the airspace building along and above Wilshire Boulevard prior to the completion of the airspace vacation requirements (VAC-E1401310) for this same area.
