

ENERGY, CLIMATE CHANGE, AND ENVIRONMENTAL JUSTICE COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the existence or creation of a transition plan when City staff and/or oil and gas operator personnel change for ongoing enforcement of existing agreements with oil and gas operators, in order to protect human health and the environment.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Koretz - Harris-Dawson for Wesson):

DIRECT the Petroleum Administrator to work with the Department of City Planning (DCP), the Los Angeles Department of Building and Safety (LADBS), and any other relevant agencies or departments to report back within 90 days on the existence or creation of an effective transition plan when City staff and/or oil and gas operator personnel change for ongoing enforcement of existing agreements with oil and gas operators, in order to effectively protect human health and the environment.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At its regular meeting held on December 3, 2019, the Energy, Climate Change, and Environmental Justice Committee considered Motion (Koretz - Harris-Dawson for Wesson) relative to instructing the Petroleum Administrator to work with the DCP, LADBS, and any other relevant agencies or departments to report on an effective transition plan when City staff and/or oil and gas operator personnel change for ongoing enforcement of existing agreements with oil and gas operators, in order to protect human health and the environment.

After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to approve the recommendation contained in the Motion, as detailed above. This matter is now transmitted to the Council for its consideration.
