Pursuant to your request, this Office has prepared and now transmits for your consideration the enclosed draft ordinance, approved as to form and legality. If adopted, this ordinance would prohibit landlords from engaging in conduct that harasses tenants in all rental housing citywide, including units protected by the Rent Stabilization Ordinance (RSO).

## CEQA Clearance

Under the exemption provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the adoption of this ordinance is exempt from the provisions of CEQA under Article 18, Section 15060 (c)(2) and 15061(b)(3), and Article II, Section 2(m) of the City CEQA Guidelines.
