

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to a report from the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) on the expectations for officers assigned to community-focused duties, and how their performance is measured.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Rodriguez - Buscaino):

DIRECT the LAPD to report in 30 days on community engagement expectations for officers assigned as Senior Lead Officers, within the Community Safety Partnership Bureau and to the Metropolitan Transportation Agency contract, and on metrics for how success is measured in these assignments.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Office nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY:

At a regular meeting held on February 3, 2021 the Public Safety Committee virtually considered a Motion (Rodriguez - Buscaino) relative to a report from the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) on the expectations for officers assigned to community-focused duties, and how their performance is measured.
