

ARTS, PARKS, HEALTH, EDUCATION, AND NEIGHBORHOODS COMMITTEE REPORT relative to establishing an off-leash dog exercise area in a portion of Joan Milke Flores Park in San Pedro delineated by appropriate signage.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Buscaino - Koretz):

1. REQUEST the City Attorney to prepare and present an Ordinance which would amend section 63.44 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code to establish an off-leash dog exercise area in a portion of Joan Milke Flores Park in San Pedro (bounded by the walking path to the north and northwest; the Roxbury Street fence line to the west; and the Paseo Del Mar fence line to the south), delineated by appropriate signage.
2. REQUEST the Board of Recreation and Park Commissioners to concur with the above recommendation and to instruct the Los Angeles Park Rangers to enforce the rules and regulations of the designated off-leash dog exercise area seven days a week.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

At its regular meeting held on February 9, 2021, the Arts, Parks, Health, Education, and Neighborhoods Committee considered Motion (Buscaino - Koretz), relative to establishing an off-leash dog exercise area in a portion of Joan Milke Flores Park in San Pedro delineated by appropriate signage. The Motion, attached to the file, includes some background on the matter.

After an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended to approve the recommendations reflected above. This matter is now submitted to the Council for consideration.
