

MOTION

I MOVE that the matter of the HOMELESSNESS AND POVERTY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to recommended local initiatives that align with the Comprehensive Crisis Response Strategy, and necessary resources for establishing a Right to Housing framework within the City, Item No. 36 on today's Council Agenda (CF 20-0102) BE AMENDED to adopt the following instruction:

Instruct the Los Angeles Housing and Community Investment Department, with the assistance of the CAO, LASHA, CLA and the City Attorney, to consult with a diversity of community stakeholders and sectors in the crafting and shaping of the 60-day report back that would outline the steps that need to be taken for LA City to establish a legislative, budgetary, administrative and policy framework to provide a Right to Housing. These stakeholders should include, but not limited to, community-based organizations and nonprofits, legal advocates, tenants and people with lived experience, faith communities, academia, philanthropy, business and other government entities such as LA County.
