

TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the feasibility of a pilot program for designating commercial loading zones for zero emission vehicles.

Recommendation for Council action, as initiated by Motion (De Leon - Bonin):

INSTRUCT the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT):

- a. To report on the feasibility of a pilot program that designated commercial loading zones for zero emission vehicles.
- b. In consultation with respective Council Offices, identify suitable locations throughout the City for this pilot program.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

On February 2, 2021, Council considered Motion (De Leon - Bonin) relative to the feasibility of a pilot program for designating commercial loading zones for zero emission vehicles. Motion states that changes are needed to achieve the goal of using 100 percent clean renewable energy as laid out in State Senate Bill 100. Much consideration has been given to zero emission passenger vehicles, less so to commercial vehicles, particularly loading trucks.

Motion movers state that Los Angeles Municipal Code Section allows the City to designate curb space for commercial vehicles for the purposes of loading and unloading goods. While the City has designated curb space for the parking of zero emission vehicles only, no areas have been designated for zero emission commercial vehicles only. Motion movers believe that Council action is needed to explore the feasibility of implementing loading zones for zero emission commercial vehicles. Motion recommended that LADOT report back relative to the feasibility of a pilot program. Council referred Motion to the Transportation Committee for consideration.

At its meeting held February 16, 2021, the Transportation Committee recommended that Council approve Motion's recommendation.
