

ORDINANCE NO. _____

An ordinance adding Subsection (j) to Section 56.08 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code to prohibit a person, whether or not acting pursuant to a City permit, to engage in conduct that obstructs the free passage of pedestrians required under the Americans with Disabilities Act.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**


Section 1. A new Subsection (j) is added to Section 56.08 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code to read as follows:

(j) No person who engages in conduct on a street, sidewalk, or other public right-of-way open for pedestrian travel, with or without a permit issued by the City under this Code, shall do so in a manner that violates the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, Pub. L. No. 101-336, 104 Stat. 328 (1990), as amended from time to time.

Sec. 2. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and have it published in accordance with Council policy, either in a daily newspaper circulated in the City of Los Angeles or by posting for ten days in three public places in the City of Los Angeles: one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall; one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall East; and one copy on the bulletin board located at the Temple Street entrance to the Los Angeles County Hall of Records.
