Summary: The Palms Neighborhood Council, representing approximately 45,000 resident stakeholders, supports Councilmember Paul Koretz's motion to ban vehicle idling. It is necessary to address the issues of poor air quality in Los Angeles due to the increasing concern over the climate emergency. At least 7 states and many cities have already implemented a vehicular idling ban. New York City has had one of the strongest all-vehicle parking idling laws for decades. We are in support of adopting the best practices from these places. Research has consistently found that it is less polluting and more fuel-efficient to turn off a modern, fuel-injected vehicle than let it idle for more than 10 seconds. The Palms NC calls on LA City Council to support the one-minute vehicular idling ban.
