Summary: The Arroyo Seco Neighborhood Council (ASNC) extends its support to this motion (21-0031) Calling for voluntary, service-based protocols for CARE+ operations citywide. For months, local activists and our unhoused neighbors have called out the cruelty of “sweeps,” also known as CARE and CARE+ operations. During COVID-19 especially, these protocols increase the risk of infection among our most vulnerable populations. The use of police in these operations strains relations that community organizations and LAHSA have built with those who are unhoused. The motion put forth by councilmembers Bonin and Raman presents a much more humane alternative that actually aims to provide services to those experiencing homelessness and the Arroyo Seco NC extends its support in these efforts.
