

ENERGY, CLIMATE CHANGE, ENVIRONMENTAL JUSTICE, AND RIVER COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the RecyclA service providers and a short-term plan commensurate with other City emergency ordinances or orders in response to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Recommendations for Council action:

1. NOTE and FILE the February 26, 2021 Bureau of Sanitation (BOS) report relative to the RecyclA service providers and a short-term plan commensurate with other City emergency ordinances or orders in response to the COVID-19 pandemic with consideration of payment deferrals, payment plans, deferred increases, and late fee waivers; and related matters.
2. INSTRUCT the BOS to report in 60 days on the status of the RecyclA impact rate relief plan.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the BOS. Neither the City Administrative officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On March 4, 2021, your Committee considered a February 26, 2021 BOS report relative to the RecyclA service providers and a short-term plan commensurate with other City emergency ordinances or orders in response to the COVID-19 pandemic with consideration of payment deferrals, payment plans, deferred increases, and late fee waivers; and related matters.
