

MOTION

The Street Furniture Revenue Fund provides funds for transit- related projects, sidewalk projects, curb/sidewalk improvements, and beautification projects needed to improve conditions for public transit patrons, and all expenses relating or incidental thereto, for each Council District.

The Los Angeles Conservation Corps will be conducting street maintenance and trash pickup in Council District Ten from July 1, 2020 to December 31, 2020. This effort is of special benefit for the residents of the City and for Council District Ten and deserves financial assistance from the City.

Sufficient funds are available in the Council District Ten portion of the Street Furniture Revenue Fund which can be allocated for this purpose.

I THEREFORE MOVE that \$95,006 of the Council District Ten portion of the Street Furniture Revenue Fund No. 43D, Department 50 be transferred to the Board of Public Works Fund No. 100-74 Account No. 3040 (Contractual Services) for street maintenance and trash pickup services throughout Council District Ten coordinated by the Los Angeles Conservation Corps.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Board of Public Works Office of Community Beautification, be authorized to prepare the necessary documents with and/or payments, including contract amendment, to the Los Angeles Conservation Corps, or any other agency or organization, in the above amount for the above purpose, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Bureau of Street Services, with the assistance of the Department of Public Works Office of Accounting and the Office of the City Controller, be authorized to make any technical corrections of clarification as necessary to the above instructions in order to effectuate the intent of the motion.
