DISCUSSION:

<u>Request</u>: The petitioner, Jake Persons of D.R. Horton Ven, Inc., is requesting the City to establish the name of the private driveways lying off Plummer Street between Natick Avenue and Cedros Avenue, as shown on Exhibit A, as Corterra Lane, Corbin Lane, and Cortez Lane.

The name establishment for the private driveways are required to identify the addresses of new condominiums associated with Tract No. 61629, currently being processed.

No objections to the proposed name have been received.

The naming of the private driveways do not signify that they are either public streets or approved private streets and are for identification purposes only.
