

ORDINANCE NO. _____

An Ordinance authorizing the quitclaim of the public transit shelter easement, lying on 4712 Santa Monica Boulevard.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The Council of the City of Los Angeles hereby finds and determines that certain easement for public transit shelter purposes hereinafter described, lying on 4712 Santa Monica Boulevard, is no longer required for the use of the City, and that the public interest, convenience and necessity require, and said Council orders, the conveyance by quitclaim deed of all the City's right, title and interest in and to said public transit shelter easement without notice of sale or advertisement for bids, to the person or persons who own the real property at the time of execution of the deed, in severalty, and upon the same tenure as their respective interests appear of record in the office of the County Recorder of Los Angeles County.

Sec. 2. The aforesaid public transit shelter easement is located in the City of Los Angeles, County of Los Angeles, State of California, and is more particularly described as follows:

That certain easement for public transit shelter purposes, 3-feet wide, lying within portions of Lot 3, of Westmoreland Park Tract, as per map recorded in Book 10, page 133, of Maps, in the office of the County Recorder of Los Angeles County, as dedicated by General Easement Deed, Document No. 01-0261351, recorded on February 15, 2001, recorded in Official Records, in the Office of the County Recorder of Los Angeles County.

Sec. 3. The following is authorized and directed:

(a) The Mayor of said City shall execute deeds in duplicate on behalf of said City, forever quitclaiming said easement above-described to the person or persons who own the real property at the time of execution of the deed;

(b) The City Clerk shall attest to and affix the City Seal to said quitclaim deeds; and

(c) The Real Estate Division of the Bureau of Engineering shall record and deliver said quitclaim deeds to the grantees named therein.

Sec. 4. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and have it published in accordance with Council policy, either in a daily newspaper circulated in the City of Los Angeles or by posting for ten days in three public places in the City of Los Angeles: one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the

Los Angeles City Hall; one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall East; and one copy on the bulletin board located at the Temple Street entrance to the Los Angeles County Hall of Records.

Sec. 5. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and have it published in accordance with Council policy, either in a daily newspaper circulated in the City of Los Angeles or by posting for ten days in three public places in the City of Los Angeles: one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall; one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall East; and one copy on the bulletin board located at the Temple Street entrance to the Los Angeles County Hall of Records.
