Our disabled over 60 need assisted living facilities. There was a missed opportunity with Saint Vincent's Hospital. The city/county had the opportunity to buy it and didn't. Over 600 beds plus land to build more. I wrote the city/county and state suggesting/begging you to buy this. We need mental health facilities with locked wards until patients are able to be released and integrated back into society. The transitional housing that has been placed in MV is not properly supervised. The city has the data on the increased crime, increased 911 calls, increased fires. We have had 2 seniors that I know of that died because of injuries suffered from contact with homeless. One lived in the 405 encampment, burned himself in hopes of not hurting others, only to now be in jail for robbery. The victim suffered a fatal heart attack. Mr Bonin is proposing the DCRC house severely mentality ill because that's the money available to build a 5 story building. Severely mentally ill people need mental health facilitates with mental health professionals. These services need to be provided outside of residential neighborhoods. Safe camping as proposed has no place in residential neighborhoods. Our parks and beaches have been funded for the public which did not include housing people.
