Dear Commissioners and Ms. Jones,

I am taking the opportunity to write in support of the Weddington Golf and Tennis property at 4141 N. Whitsett Ave in Studio City receiving a Historical-Cultural Nomination. The Weddington Golf Course is locally significant in the area of recreation and as a community recreation center. Specifically, the 9-hole golf course and driving range were constructed to provide the Studio City community with a publicly-accessible facility where children and adults alike could learn and practice the sport. The clubhouse, course, and driving range have been a community draw, for generations to a diverse demographic of Angelenos. Further, under Criterion 3. The Weddington Golf Course represents the essential characteristics of a local, community golf course in the mid-1950s. The setting has high integrity, as do the component elements including the Ranch style clubhouse that echos the residential forms of Studio City from that era, the golf course with its fairways lined in palm, eucalyptus, and pine trees, and associated features such as the golf ball-shaped light standards and putting green.

Any proposed demolition of this excellent example of a post WW II Era recreational facility will result in a significant loss to the heritage of Studio City. I urge you to protect this iconic Studio City landmark for future generations.
