# Administrative and Operations Issues

- **Improve communications**
  - clear understanding of a highly complex system
- **Data and Metrics**
  - develop meaningful measures of success

# Administrative and Operations Issues

- **LAHSA Budget**
  - improve access to information
- **One-time, Limited Funding**
  - ensure greater certainty for service providers
  - AB 71
- **Capacity and Turn-over**
  - funding uncertainty creates instability for staff

# Administrative and Operations Issues

- Outreach
  - Multiple teams
  - Multiple funding sources
  - Extensive coordination
  
  - Better alignment among all stakeholders
  - Improve understanding of roles
