SUMMARY

In a report to BOAC dated April 1, 2021, LAWA requests authority to amend its contracts with AECOM Technical Services, Inc., ICF Jones & Stokes, Inc., Landrum & Brown, Inc., and Ricondo & Associates, Inc. The firms provide entitlement, environmental, technical and consulting services necessary for project planning, environmental clearances for transportation activities, and mitigation reporting and monitoring for capital projects, on an as-needed basis. LAWA requires the extensions to complete in-progress and planned work delayed by the pandemic, as well as to respond to upcoming requests for environmental and entitlement services to support projects

that will be authorized as part of overall modernization and capital improvement programs.

On April 1, 2021, BOAC approved the proposed LAWA contract amendments.

At its meeting held May 11, 2021, the Trade, Travel, and Tourism Committee recommended that Council approve the proposed contract amendments, as recommended by BOAC.
