<p>In response to the amendments adopted by the PLUM Committee on February 16, 2021 the following documents are transmitted:</p> <p>Revised Notice of Exemption (NOE) Modification to the Negative Declaration (ENV-2020-4927-ND) Updated Fee Assessment Revised Findings Resolution</p> <p>Recommended Actions:</p> <p>Recommend that the City Council adopt the proposed Ordinance, as transmitted as to form and legality on May 13, 2021 by the City Attorney.</p> <p>Recommend that the City Council determine, based on the whole of the administrative record, that the Project is exempt from CEQA pursuant to California Public Resources Code Section 21080.25 and CEQA Guidelines, Section 15301 (Class 1), and there is no substantial evidence demonstrating that an exception to a Categorical Exemption pursuant to CEQA Guidelines, Section 15300.2 applies.</p> <p>Recommend that the City Council determine, pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15074(b), after consideration of the whole of the administrative record, including the Negative Declaration, No. ENV-2020-4927-ND, the modification to Negative Declaration dated May 13, 2021, and all comments received, there is no substantial evidence that the project will have a significant effect on the environment; find the Negative Declaration reflects the independent judgement and analysis of the City; and adopt the Negative Declaration.</p> <p>Recommend that the City Council adopt the revised findings of fact.</p> <p>Recommend that the City Council adopt the enabling Resolution activating the provisions of the Ordinance, in response to the Local Emergency declaration originally issued March 4, 2020 and subsequently affirmed, amended, extended and ongoing.</p>
