The CHC determined " that the property conforms with the definition of a Monument pursuant to Section 22.171.7 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code. The Commission also voted to change the proposed monument's name back to "Studio City Golf and Tennis Club" to reflect the original, historic name. (It is currently known as Weddington Golf and Tennis). The nomination is for the property, the clubhouse, golf course, and driving range that have been open to the public for generations to a diverse demographic of Angelenos. Under Criterion 3. The setting has high integrity, as do the component elements including the Ranch style clubhouse, the golf course with its fairways lined with over 350 palm, eucalyptus, and pine trees, and associated features such as the golf ball-shaped light standards and putting green. Any proposed demolition of this excellent example of a post WW II Era recreational facility will result in a significant loss to the heritage of Studio City. I urge you to protect this iconic Studio City landmark for future generations.
