PLANNING AND LAND USE MANAGEMENT (PLUM) COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the feasibility of expanding the provisions of the existing Interim Motel Conversion Ordinance to existing commercial office buildings, and changes to the Motel Conversion Ordinance to allow the repurposing or adaptation of commercial office buildings into supportive and transitional housing with supportive services.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Bonin – Koretz – Raman):

- INSTRUCT the Department of City Planning (DCP), Los Angeles Housing and Community Investment Department (HCIDLA), and City Attorney, in consultation with the Los Angeles Department of Building and Safety (LADBS) and the Los Angeles Fire Department (LAFD), to report on feasibility of and recommendations for expanding the provisions of the existing Interim Motel Conversion Ordinance to existing commercial office buildings.
- 2. REQUEST the City Attorney to prepare draft changes to the Motel Conversion Ordinance that would allow the repurposing or adaptation of commercial office buildings into supportive and transitional housing with supportive services.
