

INFORMATION, TECHNOLOGY, AND GENERAL SERVICES COMMITTEE REPORT relative to a new month-to-month license agreement with the Judicial Council of California for office space at the San Fernando Courthouse located at 900 Third Street.

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE the Department of General Services, on behalf of the City Attorney and the Los Angeles Police Department, to negotiate and execute a new month-to-month license agreement with the Judicial Council of California for office space at the San Fernando Courthouse located at 900 Third Street, San Fernando, CA, with a retroactive start date of July 1, 2020.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The Municipal Facilities Committee (MFC) reports that there is no additional General Fund impact for the current year beyond monies budgeted within the citywide leasing account. Of the total cost of \$79,012 for this lease, \$17,052 was budgeted for this purpose as part of the 2020-21 City Budget. The remaining \$61,960 in unbudgeted costs will be offset using a contingency reserve set aside for projected increases in multiple courthouse leases, which will be fully depleted once all pending courthouse lease executions are authorized and become effective.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At the meeting held on June 3, 2021, your Information, Technology, and General Services Committee considered a MFC report relative to a new month-to-month license agreement with the Judicial Council of California for office space at the San Fernando Courthouse located at 900 Third Street. After an opportunity for public comment was held, the Committee moved to approve the MFC's recommendation, as detailed above. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
