

ENERGY, CLIMATE CHANGE, ENVIRONMENTAL JUSTICE, AND RIVER COMMITTEE REPORT relative to an ordinance allowing the Board of Public Works to use a Design-Build contract for the delivery of the Bureau of Sanitation Clean Water and Stormwater Control System Upgrade and Integration Project.

Recommendation for Council action:

REQUEST the City Attorney to prepare and present an Ordinance according to Section 371 to allow the Board of Public Works to use a Design-Build contract for the delivery of the Bureau of Sanitation Clean Water and Stormwater Control System Upgrade and Integration Project.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The Board of Public Works reports that there is no impact on the General fund. Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

At its meeting held on June 3, 2021, the Energy, Climate Change, Environmental Justice, and River Committee considered the April 28, 2021 Board of Public Works report relative to an ordinance allowing the Board of Public Works to use a Design-Build contract for the delivery of the Bureau of Sanitation Clean Water and Stormwater Control System Upgrade and Integration Project.
