

PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the development of an outdoor performance program.

Recommendations for Council action, as initiated by Motion (Raman, Krekorian, Bonin - Cedillo):

1. INSTRUCT the Bureau of Street Services, with the assistance of the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA), Los Angeles Department of Transportation, Bureau of Engineering, Los Angeles Department of Building and Safety, City Attorney, and any other necessary departments to report within 60 days with recommendations for the development of an outdoor event permit program as outlined in the original Motion, attached to the Council file, and with guidance on noise and sound levels for events in residential and business areas including regulations for amplified sound.
2. INSTRUCT the Office of Finance to report within 60 days on the feasibility of waiving City taxes and fees levied on music venues for a two-year period and to include cost estimates.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the CLA has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At the meeting held on June 23, 2021, your Public Works Committee considered a Motion (Raman, Krekorian, Bonin - Cedillo) relative to the development of an outdoor performance program, and related matters.
