Honorable Members:

On June 30, 2021, our Office transmitted a draft ordinance that would replace Section 41.18 of the Los Angeles Municipal Code (LAMC) to specify the particular times and locations where it shall be unlawful for a person to sit, lie, or sleep, or store, use, maintain, or place personal property in the public right-of-way. On July 1, 2021, the City Council approved an amendment to the draft ordinance that added a Subsection (e) to define the specific penalties associated with violations of the new Section 41.18, rather than defaulting to the standard penalties set forth in Section 11.00 of the LAMC. Attached is the revised draft ordinance, approved as to form and legality, to add Subsection (e) to Section 41.18 of the LAMC.
