

HOMELESSNESS AND POVERTY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to working with the local service providers to develop a pilot storage program.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Blumenfield - Krekorian):

1. INSTRUCT the Bureau of Sanitation (BOS) to work with Los Angeles Homeless Service Authority and the local service providers in Council District 3 to develop a pilot storage program where residents at these facilities can store their excess belongings at local storage facilities to ensure a smooth transition from the street into temporary housing.
2. INSTRUCT that City Administrative Officer (CAO) and Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA) be requested to identify sources of funding and any necessary contract amendments to implement this pilot program.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY:

At a regular meeting held on April 8, 2021, the Homelessness and Poverty Committee considered Motion (Blumenfield - Krekorian) relative to working with the local service providers to develop a pilot storage program in CD 3. After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended on consent to adopt the Motion. This matter is now submitted to the Council for consideration.
