Re: FY 2020 Urban Areas Security Initiative (UASI) Contracting Authorities and Budget Modifications (Council File No. 20-1156)

Dear Honorable Members:

Transmitted herewith for City Council consideration are proposed contracting authorities and budget modifications related to the United States Department of Homeland Security (DHS) Fiscal Year 2020 Urban Areas Security Initiative (FY20 UASI) grant award. On March 24, 2021, the City Council accepted the FY20 UASI grant in the amount of \$56,236,000 with a grant performance period from September 1, 2020 to May 31, 2023 (Council File No. 20-1156).

Glendale Subrecipient Agreement

In FY20 UASI, the Interagency Communications Interoperability System Authority (ICI) received an allocation of \$270,000 to fund upgrades and maintenance at one communications site located within the City of Glendale. These funds have since been modified to the City of Glendale, who will oversee and implement the project. This modification resulted in the need for a contract amendment to increase the City of Glendale total contract amount by \$270,000 from the previously authorized amount of \$866,102, to a new contract amount of \$1,136,102. This modification was approved by the grantor on February 18, 2020.

The Mayor's Office requests authority to modify the FY20 UASI grant budget, conduct the necessary transfer of appropriations, and amend the subrecipient agreement for the City of Glendale as detailed above.

American Red Cross

In FY20 UASI, the American Red Cross Los Angeles Chapter (ARC) received an allocation of \$119,725 to fund the purchase of durable medical equipment. Due to unforeseen circumstances, ARC is no longer able to expend these funds and has returned their entire allocation to support regional Emergency Management and Health Services projects.

\$19,954 has been allocated to the Los Angeles City Emergency Management Department (EMD) to increase funding to the Defense Support of Civil Authorities (DSCA) full-scale exercise in 2022. The remaining funds have been distributed to the County of Los Angeles Office of Emergency Management (\$19,955), the City of Long Beach (\$49,885), and the City of Pasadena Health Department (\$29,931). These modifications are pending grantor approval.

The Mayor's Office requests authority to modify the FY20 UASI grant budget and conduct the necessary transfer of appropriations as detailed above.

Recommendations

It is therefore requested that the City Council:

1. **Authorize** the Mayor, or designee, to:
 - a. Modify the existing grant budget (Council File No. 20-1156) for the FY20 UASI grant by reallocating funds between projects and conducting the necessary fiscal transfers as described within this report; and
 - b. Negotiate and execute a contract amendment with the City of Glendale to increase its total contract amount by \$270,000, from the previously authorized amount of \$866,102, to a new contract amount of \$1,136,102, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form.

2. **Authorize** the Controller to:

- a. Transfer appropriations within Fund 64E, FY20 UASI, as follows:
