Comments for Public Posting: Our family is opposed to spending the \$300k on a feasibility of creating "temporary" housing for the homeless at Westchester Park as well as the beach locations proposed. These locations are completely inappropriate for use by the homeless population. Rather, alternative locations should be considered such as LAX Northside or possibly property owned by LAWA in Palmdale. Homeless individuals should not be scattered throughout the City but rather located as part of a larger project to benefit from "economy of scale". Perhaps the City could partner with Habitat for Humanity to develop a plan, which could possibly help getting local communities involved in implementation. I suggest that the Convention Center be considered as a "temporary" shelter to satisfy Judge Carter's ruling while more permanent housing is under construction.
