


MOTION






I MOVE that the matter of Motion (Martinez, O'Farrell - Harris-Dawson, Raman) relative to COVID-19 vaccination requirements for eligible individuals entering indoor spaces, Item No. 19 on today's Council Agenda (C.F. 21-0878) BE AMENDED to include the following additional recommendations:

5. Instruct the Chief Legislative Analyst, working with the Economic Workforce and Development Department and the City Attorney, to solicit input from businesses, business organizations and Council Offices on the types of public spaces that should be included in the draft ordinance.
6. Instruct the Chief Legislative Analyst, working with the Community Investment for Families Department and the City Attorney, to solicit input from parents, parent groups, teachers, pediatricians, and non-profit organizations/businesses that deliver childcare services, and incorporate in the draft ordinance how best to protect children 12 years and younger given that this age group remains ineligible to receive a vaccine.
