

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to authority to accept a sub-grant award from the County of Los Angeles (County), and negotiate and execute a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) and the County for the Fiscal Year (FY) 2021-22 Regional Threat Assessment Center (RTAC) Program.

Recommendations for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

1. AUTHORIZE the Chief, LAPD, or designee to:
 - a. Accept the sub-grant award of \$52,000 from the County, by and through the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department, for the participation in the RTAC Program, with funding from the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services' FY 2019 Homeland Security Grant Program (HSGP).
 - b. Negotiate and execute a MOA between the LAPD and the County for the FY 2021-22 RTAC Program, commencing upon execution of the agreement through May 31, 2022, for a total of \$52,000, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form.
2. AUTHORIZE the LAPD to:
 - a. Spend up to the total grant amount of \$52,000 in accordance with the grant agreement.
 - b. Submit grant reimbursement requests to the grantor and deposit the grant receipts in the LAPD Grant Fund No. 339/70.
 - c. Prepare Controller instructions for any technical adjustments as necessary to implement Mayor and Council intentions, subject to the approval of the City Administrative Officer (CAO); and, authorize the Controller to implement the instructions.
3. AUTHORIZE the Controller to:
 - a. Establish a grant receivable and appropriate \$52,000 to appropriation account, account number to be determined, within Fund No. 339/70, for the receipt and disbursement of the FY 2021-22 RTAC Program grant funds.
 - b. Increase appropriations for the FY 2021-22 RTAC Program grant as needed from appropriation account, account number to be determined, in Fund No. 339/70 to Fund No. 100/70, account number and amount as follows:

Account No. 001092, Overtime Sworn \$25,000
4. **INSTRUCT the City Clerk to:**
 - a. **Place the following action relative to the FY 2021-22 RTAC Program on the Council agenda on July 1, 2021 or the first meeting thereafter:**

Authorize the Controller to transfer from Fund No. 339/70, appropriation account, account number to be determined, to Fund No. 100/70, account number and amount as follows:

Account No. 001092, Overtime Sworn \$27,000

Fiscal Impact Statement: The CAO reports that approval of the recommendations within this report will have no additional impact to the General Fund. Under the MOA, the County is the recipient of the FY 2019 HSGP award from the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services, and has granted the LAPD a sub-award of \$52,000 of the FY 2019 HSGP funding to participate in the RTAC Program, in accordance with the grant award agreement.

Financial Policies Statement: The CAO reports that the recommendations provided in this report are in compliance with the City's Financial Policies in that all grant funds will be utilized for grant-eligible activities.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At a regular meeting held on August 4, 2021 the Public Safety Committee virtually considered CAO and Board of Police Commissioners reports relative to authority to accept a sub-grant award from the County, and negotiate and execute a MOA between the LAPD and the County for the FY 2021-22 RTAC Program. After providing an opportunity for public comment the Committee approved the recommendations in the CAO report dated June 11, 2021, as detailed above. This matter is now transmitted to Council for its consideration.
