INFORMATION, TECHNOLOGY, AND GENERAL SERVICES COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the City's efforts to mitigate and prepare for climate change.

Recommendations for Council action, pursuant to Motion (Raman - Koretz):

- DIRECT the Department of General Services (GSD) Fleet and Supply Divisions, working with any
  other relevant divisions or departments and, as needed, the Mayor's EV Task Force, the Chief
  Procurement Officer, and the City Administrative Officer (CAO), to report within 60 days with
  proposed rules to meet the intent of the Zero-Emission First procurement policy and a proposed
  compliance or certification process.
- 2. DIRECT the GSD to report on staffing and funding needs to ensure that EV charging infrastructure, or any other zero-emission fueling infrastructure, will be installed in parallel to or in anticipation of a future 100% zero-emission municipal fleet.
- 3. DIRECT the Los Angeles Police Department and Los Angeles Fire Department to report within 60 days on their short, medium, and long-term plans to transition their fleets to zero-emission vehicles, inclusive of specialty and pursuit-rated vehicles (excluding aerial equipment).
- 4. DIRECT the Los Angeles Department of Transportation to report within 60 days on the progress toward meeting the bus-electrification targets previously established by Council.
- 5. REQUEST that the Los Angeles World Airports, Port of Los Angeles, and Los Angeles Department of Water and Power report within 60 days on how they will codify and implement the Zero-Emission First fleet procurement rule.

<u>Fiscal Impact Statement</u>: Neither the CAO nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.
