INSTRUCT the Department of General Services, with the assistance of the City Attorney and the City Administrative Officer (CAO), to negotiate a no-cost lease agreement with the Canoga Park Community Foundation, or its successor organization; to include the following basic elements: an initial 3-year term with two (2) one-year options to extend; zero rent with the non-profit responsible for maintenance and basic repair of the facility; and allowing subleases and room rentals, including but not limited to the Canoga Park Neighborhood Council.
