BACKGROUND

On October 16, 1996, the Los Angeles City Council (referred hereafter as Council) passed Ordinance No. 171378 to create the Los Angeles Police Department (referred hereafter as Department) Revolving Training Fund (RTF). The RTF was approved for an annual budget of \$1,000,000.00. Ordinance No. 174756 (referred hereafter as Ordinance) increased the RTF budget to \$1,500,000.00 on August 13, 2002.

The Ordinance states that the RTF shall only be expended for the following purposes:

- The payment of travel, per diem, and tuition related to training;
- Expense and equipment directly related to the delivery of training within the Department; and,
- Short term rental of training facilities (no more than five days).

The RTF is funded through revenue from:

- Reimbursements from POST for Department-incurred expenses for presenting POST-certified courses;
- Reimbursements from POST for per diem, tuition, and travel expenses incurred by Department personnel while attending POST-reimbursable courses;
- Tuition fees received from outside agencies whose employees attended Department training; and,
- College affiliation.

PURPOSE

The Ordinance requires the Department to report semi-annually to the Council the status of the RTF, the accounting of fund expenditures, and revenue. This report was prepared by Senior Personnel Analyst Donna Baylosis, Serial No. N3198, and Management Analyst Juan Rodarte, Serial No. N5259, Peace Officer Standards and Training Liaison Unit, Training Bureau.

PRIOR REPORT

The last semi-annual report submitted was prepared by Management Analyst Juan Rodarte, Serial No. N5259, Peace Officer Standards and Training Liaison Unit, Training Bureau, and forwarded to and approved by Council. The prior report summarized the first half of Fiscal Year 2020/2021, July 1 through December 31, 2020.

METHODOLOGY

This report covers the period from January 1 through June 30, 2021. During the reporting period, the RTF was administered by the Department's Training Bureau (TRB) and Fiscal Group (FG).

Additionally, in accordance with Mayor Eric Garcetti's directive as outlined in the March 12, 2020 *City of Los Angeles Memorandum – COVID-19 CITY GUIDELINES*, all Department travel requests require review and approval from the Office of the Chief of Police or designee. Upon approval from the Office of the Chief of Police or designee, TRB and FG respective duties for the RTF included:

Training Bureau Functions

- Preparation of a budget for a given fiscal year;
- The initial review and approval of expenditures;
- The preparation of documents required to process expenditures;
- Bills and collects tuition from outside agencies for training provided by the Department.

Fiscal Group Functions

- Receives a copy of the paperwork generated by TRB and requests the warrants from the Controller's Office to be used for the expenditure;
- Receives and audits Personal Expense Statements from traveler;
- Receives and deposits reimbursements received from POST, affiliation fees collected from College of the Canyons and other appropriate revenue sources;
- Determines the RTF budget's total amount per fiscal year.

This report utilizes information taken from databases operated by TRB and FG, and reports generated from the City of Los Angeles Financial Management System (FMS). The TRB and FG databases were reconciled and used to report on expenditures. The FMS data was used to generate the reports on revenue. The Department continues to modify its systems to enhance the tracking and reporting of the RTF.

FINDINGS

THE RTF BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020/2021

The RTF's budget for a given fiscal year consists of the revenue from the previous fiscal year and unencumbered funds from prior fiscal years. For Fiscal Year 2020/2021, the RTF had available \$1,500,000.00. The RTF budget (Addenda A) allowed for:

- \$1,250,000.00 for professional development; and,
- \$250,000.00 for tuition reimbursement.

To help ensure that the RTF is adequately replenished, the RTF is separated into a Reimbursable and a Non-Reimbursable Account. Expenditures that are reimbursable by POST were paid from the Reimbursable Account. Conversely, expenditures that were not to be reimbursed were paid from the Non-Reimbursable Account. The RTF budget consisted of:

- \$1,500,000.00 as non-reimbursable.

TRAVEL AUTHORITY PROCESS

The usage and the approval of RTF funds are closely tied to the Department's Travel Authorities (TA). The process (Figure 1) allows all Department employees and entities the ability to access the RTF. During this reporting period, up to eight commanding officers reviewed and approved the requests for TAs.

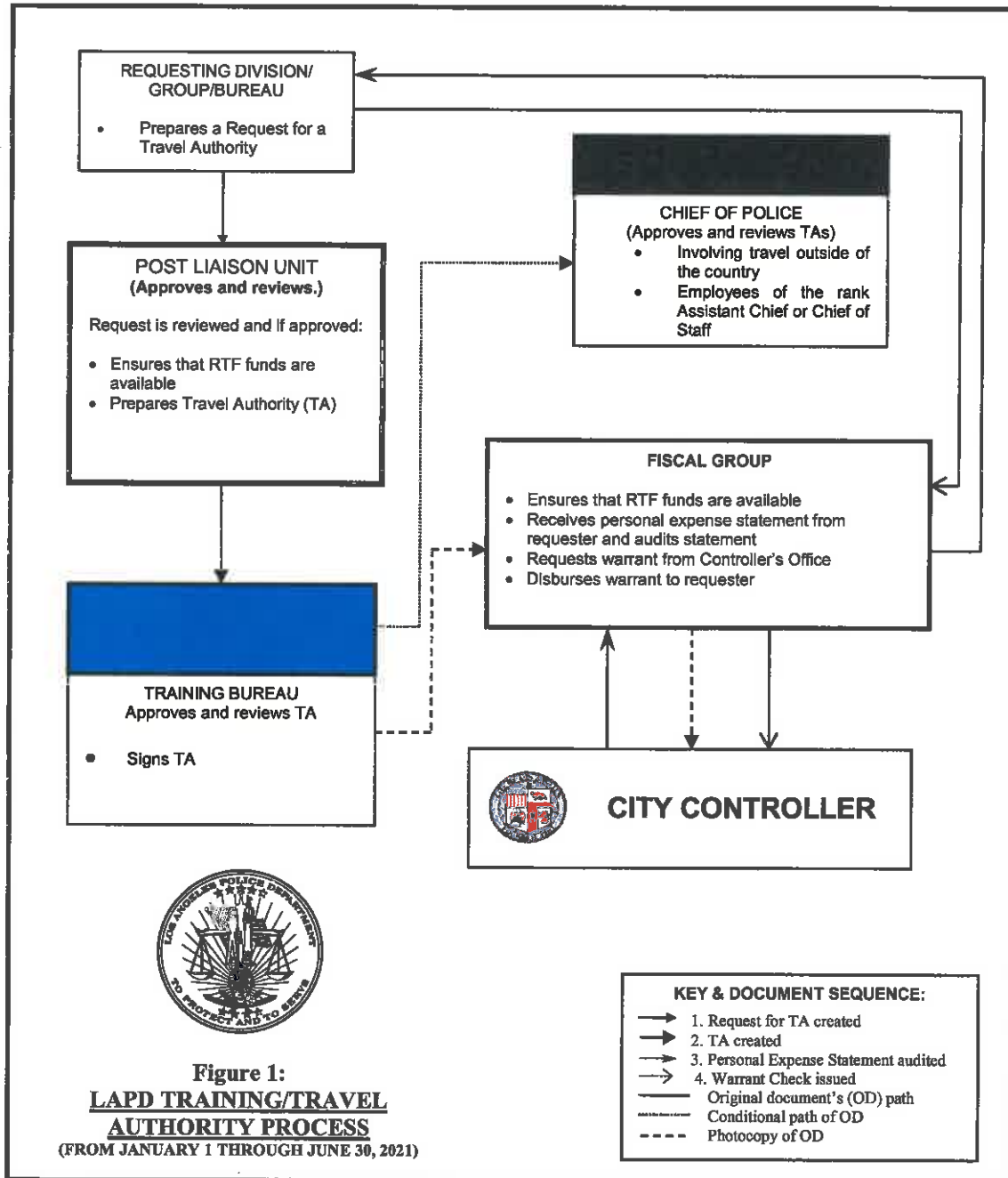

At each level of review, the Requests for TAs were reviewed for various criteria that included:

- Appropriateness of the training with respect to the employee's title or rank, current assignment and job duties;
- Appropriateness of transportation;
- Value of the training to the Department;
- The benefit of the training relative to the outlay of funds;
- Timeliness of the request;
- Deployment issues; and,
- Intradepartmental memos.

THE RTF EXPENDITURES

From January 1 through June 30, 2021, the Department expended \$123,756.81 on a variety of courses and college tuition (Addendum B and E). Of the expenditures:

- \$123,756.81 (which includes the tuition reimbursement amount of \$93,714.12) was spent from the non-reimbursable account.

RTF REVENUES

For the reporting period of January 1 through June 30, 2021 (Fiscal Year 2020/2021), the Department deposited \$79,881.62 in revenue from various sources (Addendum C). A historical overview of revenues from the four previous Fiscal Years (2016/2017, 2017/2018, 2018/2019, and 2019/2020) is also captured (Addendum D).

Fiscal Year 2020/2021 revenues are lower compared to previous fiscal years due to unprecedented restrictions placed on LAPD training and travel due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The social distancing restrictions created limited opportunities to provide training, which had a negative impact on the RTF revenue.

EXPENDITURE PLAN

The Los Angeles Police Department's (Department) Revolving Training Fund (RTF) is budgeted for \$1,500,000 annually. The RTF budget is funded through revenue, in the form of receipts and reimbursements from the California Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST), payment for training from outside agencies, and the College Affiliation Program.

The RTF is divided into two accounts, reimbursable and non-reimbursable. The Reimbursable Account is allotted for expenditures that will be reimbursed by POST. The Non-Reimbursable Account is for expenditures that will not be reimbursed.

During Fiscal Year (FY) 2019/2020, the RTF received \$2,393,934.57 in revenue. \$1,500,000 of the revenue received was allocated to the RTF account for FY 2020/2021 (\$1,160,000.00 to the Non-Reimbursable Account and \$340,000.00 to the Reimbursable Account). The remaining balance was deposited into the City of Los Angeles General Fund. Currently, the RTF has received \$1,711,079.36 in revenue for FY 2020/2021.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, training and travel have been limited to essential training or travel only. As a result, the RTF was divided into two training categories: Professional Development and College Tuition Reimbursement. The categories are defined as follows:

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

This category includes courses that enhance, develop, and update the expertise of all Department employees, including discretionary executive development courses, equipment and facility rental.

COLLEGE TUITION REIMBURSEMENT

This category is for reimbursement of tuition expenditures for Department personnel who attend certificate and degree programs presented by various accredited colleges. The program is open to all full-time Department personnel.

The chart provides a breakdown of the RTF funding between the two categories.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Fiscal Year 2020/2021 Revolving Training Fund budget is divided into two-line items, the College Tuition Reimbursement and the Discretionary Fund. Because it is unknown how long travel, training, and social distancing restrictions will last, authorization for use of the Discretionary Fund will be evaluated on a case by case basis by Training Bureau. The chart on the proceeding page provides the RTF expenditures by category and its corresponding line item.

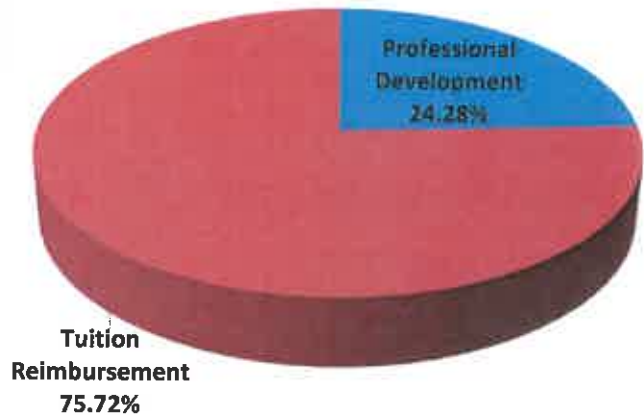

EXPENDITURES BY TRAINING CATEGORY

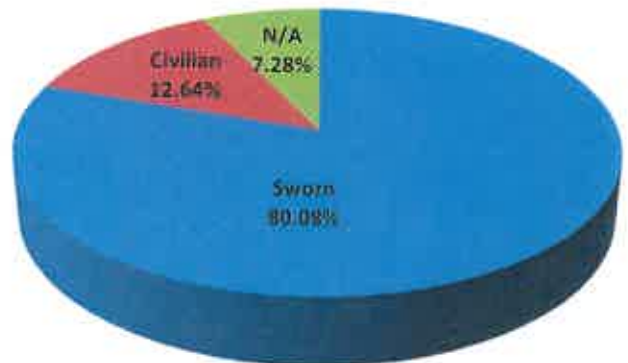

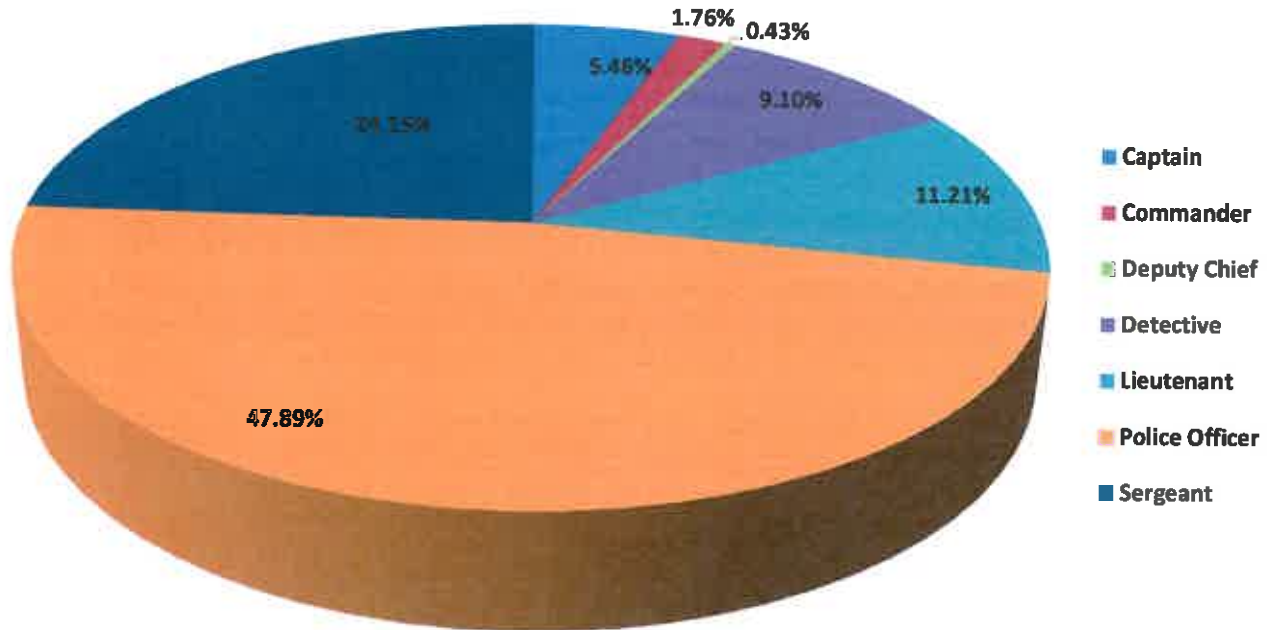

EXPENDITURE BY SWORN CLASSIFICATION



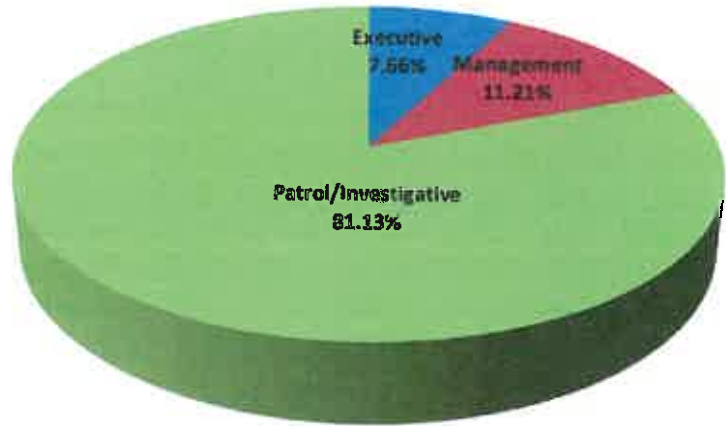

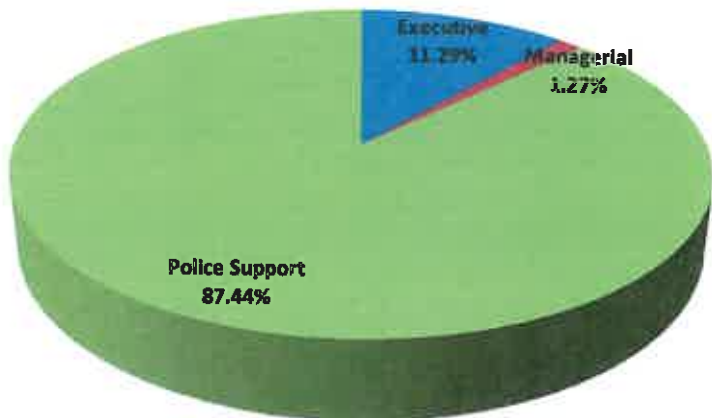

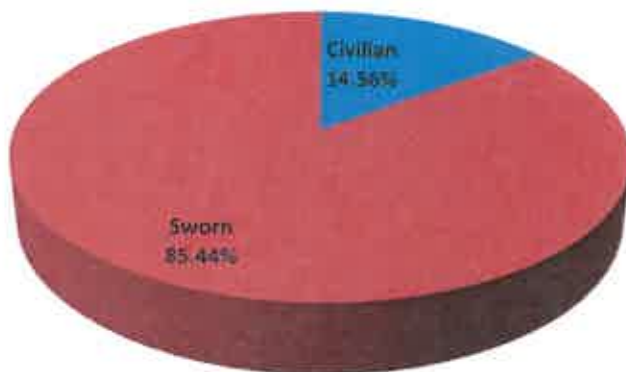

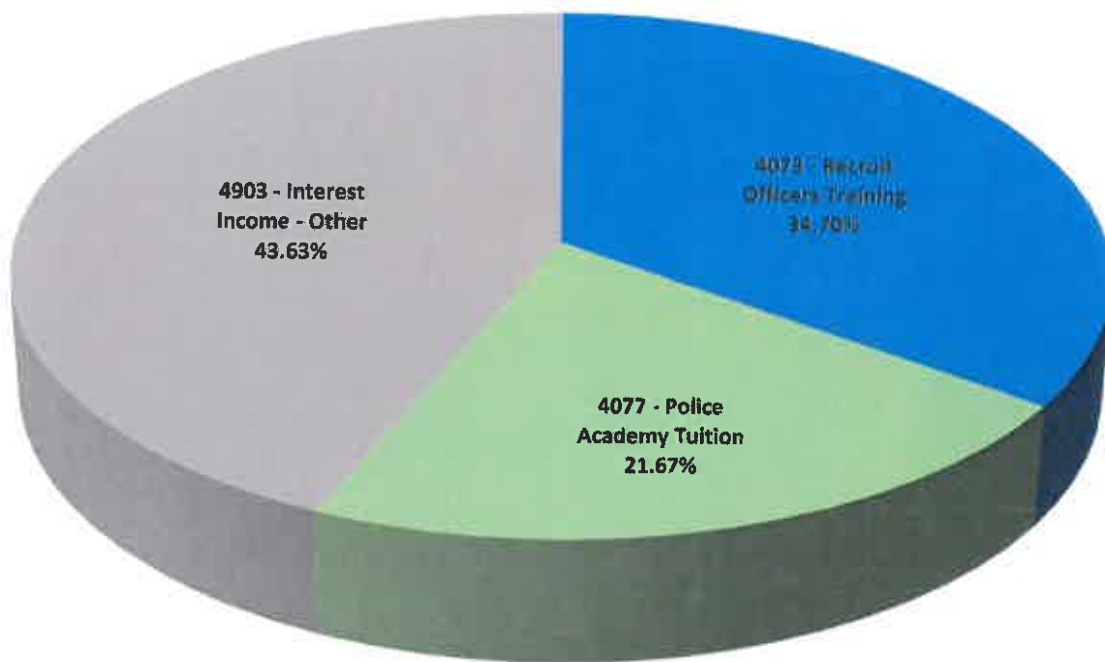

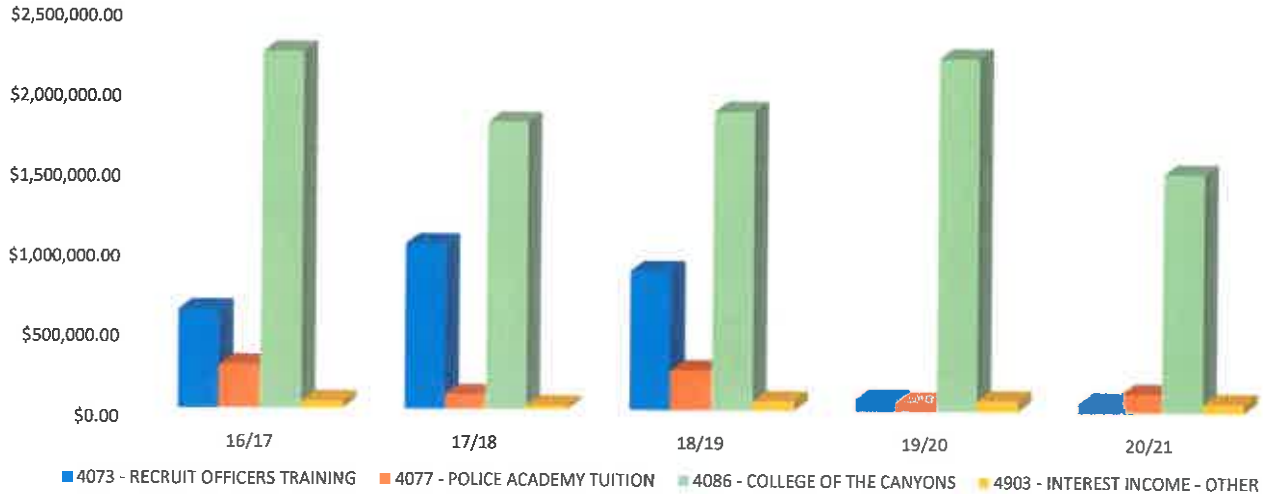
