REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to including the City's position in the 2021-22 State Legislative Program for AB 525 (Chiu), which would require the California Energy Commission to develop a strategic plan for achieving 3,000 megawatts (MW) of offshore wind development off the California coast by 2030, and at least 10,000 MW by 2040.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Buscaino – O'Farrell),  
SUBJECT TO THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MAYOR:

ADOPT the accompanying RESOLUTION relative to including in the City's 2021-22 State Legislative Program, SUPPORT for AB 525 (Chiu), which would require the California Energy Commission to develop a strategic plan for achieving 3,000 MW of offshore wind development off the California coast by 2030, and at least 10,000 MW by 2040.
